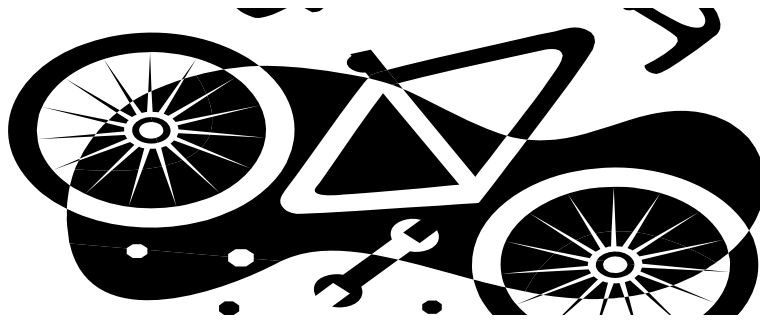

## VULNERABLE USER'S BILL

The Hawaii Bicycling League and Maui Bicycle Alliance are working on a bill to increase legal protection for vulnerable roadway users such as pedestrians, skaters, cyclists, and roadway workers. If passed, the bill will raise the penalties for traffic violations that result in the serious bodily injury or death of a vulnerable user, and will require people to be especially careful when driving near unprotected roadway users. This bill should help drivers become more aware of the vulnerable users they share the road with every day.

- 1) Describe the accident, including relevant details.
- 2) How did the driver of the vehicle break the law?

- 6) How was your case resolved?
