

## Bike Ed Quarter 1 Report 2016-2017

Bike Ed got off to a great start with two new enthusiastic instructors and team manager. The children were excited to begin the school year's first quarter at Holomua Elementary and end at Ewa Beach Elementary, with a total of 18 schools serviced island wide. There were 296 beginner (non riders) learning the skill of balancing on a bike and gaining confidence under the watchful tutelage of Bike Ed instructors.

In the classroom students were taught how to wear a properly fitted helmet and vest and given instruction on how to do a 6 point bike safety check. Outside on the basketball court specific drills were taught teaching bike handling and braking skills.

Last the students had the opportunity to exercise their skills on the neighborhood roads practicing how to navigate the streets, stopping at signs and making left turns. Overall the experience proved enjoyable in the first quarter for a total of 1867 students. The Bike Ed instructors, teachers and volunteer parents had just as much fun too!
