

## Bike Ed Quarter 2 Report 2016-2017 Hawaii Bicycling League

The rainy season of the second quarter did not deter Bike Ed instructors and students from enjoying their training sessions in class, on campus and out on the neighborhood streets. Periodically everyone would have to wait for the rain to subside but as soon as the sun came out the students were doing their 6 point bike safety check and putting on their hi-visibility bike vests.

HBL's team of instructors served 25 schools. There were 1,634 students who knew how to ride (riders) and 347 beginners (non riders) throughout the quarter.

Overall, Bike Ed helped 1,981 students either learn to ride a bike or become more proficient riders by learning the rules of the road and how to be safe on the streets of Oahu. HBL also had the support of many parent and teacher volunteers helping to sweep rides or patiently balance students on bikes as they rolled across the basketball courts.
