

HBL Bike Ed Quarter 3 Report 2016-2017

The BikeEd Program reached 1,195 fourth graders at 24 schools in the third quarter of the 2016-17 school year. In quarter three there were 315 beginners (non-riders) and 1,195 confident riders at the start of the BikeEd week.

At the beginning of the week students scored an average of 76% correctness on the pre-test. By the end of the program students scored an average of 94% correctness on the same set of safety questions. The BikeEd student ‘thank you’ notes, which HBL receives from schools after they have had BikeEd, also exemplify how much the students learn! The kids write about the 6-point safety check, staying on check-point (3 feet away from parked cars or curbs), how to make proper driveway exits, and right and left hand turns! Look at the artwork (pictured below)!

HBL’s BikeEd Program also participated in two community events in quarter three of school year 2016-2017. A Walk on the Wild Side Bike Rodeo and the Coca Cola Family Bottling Company Rodeo reached 59 keiki from the community! These events teach safety and help kids to improve their cycling skills.
