

HBL Bike Ed Quarter 4 Report 2016-2017

The BikeEd Program reached 20 schools in the fourth quarter of the 2016-17 school year. The BikeEd Instructors taught 2,170 fourth graders how to navigate safely while riding a bicycle, rules of the road, and (for some) how to ride a bike. Classroom presentations were done at 5 schools towards year's end when it was not possible to schedule the usual BikeEd classes. This school year, the instructors have noticed an increase in the number of fourth graders who don't know how to ride a bicycle upon starting the program. There were 419 beginners (non-riders) starting out in the fourth quarter and 954 confident riders at the start of the program.

Students demonstrated an increase in knowledge scoring an average of 75% on the pre-test prior to participating in the BikeEd Program and an average of 91% correctness at the end of the program.

BikeEd instructors also held four community events: the Aloha Fun Ride Bike to the Zoo, the Aloha Fun Ride on the Pearl Harbor Bike Path, a Waimanalo Fun Ride, and a Family Sunday Bike Rodeo in collaboration with the Honolulu Museum of Art. These events incorporate BikeEd keiki, their ohana, and some families from the general community. We incorporate the six-point safety check, education around rules of the road, and fun!
