League Cycling Instructor - \$25/hour

Are you interested in mastering bicycling in an urban environment? Would you like to teach other cyclists and motorists the magic dance of sharing the road?

We are looking for responsible, enthusiastic and passionate people who are committed to making Oʻahu better and safer for bicyclists, pedestrians, and motorists to become League Cycling Instructors (LCI) – as recognized by the League of American Bicyclists (LAB) and the Hawaii Bicycle League (HBL) – and teach cycling workshops.

Minimum qualifications:

- Need to be a proficient bicyclist and own a fully functioning bicycle, helmet, and lights
- Passionate about making the roads safer for bicyclists
- · Responsible, self-directed, with good communication skills
- Desire to teach others
- Committed to completing entire LCI training (see below) and teaching at least two courses between April 2016 September 2016
- Active member of the League of American Bicyclists (\$25+/yr membership fee) and the Hawaii Bicycling League (\$25+/yr membership fee) at time of selection

LCI training involves 2 components: A) completing Traffic Skills 101 (TS101) and B) League Cycling Instructor course. **BOTH COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED.** Course descriptions found below.

TS101 - A 9-hour course teaching on-road cycling, evasive maneuvering, and the basics of bike maintenance. Involves both in-class and on-road instruction.

League Cycling Instructor Course – 23-hour course thoroughly covering riding tactics, principles, and skills to effectively and safely teach TS101. Involves both in-class and on-road instruction. Certified instructors will be

able to teach HBL workshops and be paid \$25/hour.

Course schedule

TS101 will be offered on February 27th, from 8:30-4:30pm at the Hawaii Bicycling League office. The curriculum roughly covers the material that the three cycling workshops HBL teach so that participants are familiar with what they will be instructing. Students will also be reviewed on execution of bicycle drills and attitude.

The <u>LCI seminar</u> will be held on <u>April 8, 9 and 10</u>; LCI candidates must be present for all parts of the three-day seminar:

- Friday, April 8th: 5-9pm
- Saturday, April 9th: 8am-9pm
- Sunday, April 10th: 10:30am-5:30pm

The LCI seminar costs \$300 to attend but you will be reimbursed fully by HBL after teaching seven workshops. If you need help paying that fee up front please contact Malia@HBL.org and we can work something out.

Teaching

We will be teaching an array of different cycling workshops and holding various presentations around the island. LCIs (you and the others trained) will work together to teach approximately 80 courses and will be paid \$25 per teaching hour. Each LCI must teach at least two courses. Courses to be taught will start mid-April. LCI certification does not expire and is recognized nationally.
