

- 4.8 Right at intersection with H-1 Hwy,
- 10.0 Left at Lunalilo Home Rd.
- 11.7 Right, steep climb up Hawaii Kai Dr.
- 12.8 Right on Kealahou St.
- 13.6 Left on Kalanianaole Hwy., begin climb
- 15.3 End
