Hawaii Bicycling League Neighborhood Advocacy Meeting

Kalihi, Kalihi Valley (Neighborhood Boards 15, 16)

The large group involved a number of youth from the KVICE program. The group generally thought Kalihi and Kalihi Valley needed lots of improvements to be bike friendly. The group had relative consensus on two priority projects, but felt that many improvements were needed.

Biggest priorities:

- School St – Seen as unavoidable for Kalihi Valley and dangerous for bicyclists (and pedestrians) in its current form. Bike lanes are seen as essential.
- North King St – Seen as unavoidable for Kalihi and dangerous for bicyclists (and pedestrians) in its current form. Protected bike lanes are desired.

Other bikeway items:

- Gulich Ave – needs bike lanes – with the current bike it's no good "cars don't share"
- Dillingham Blvd – need bike lanes
- Bicycle boulevard with "back streets" – Kaumualii St, lower section of Gulich Ave, other little streets
- Middle St – need bike lanes to connect to bike path
