Major Priorities:

- Complete the Leeward Bikeway this is particularly crucial to provide a connection between Kapolei to Ko Olina and Waianae Coast, where currently Farrington Hwy is the only option
- Continuous bike lanes and bike paths on Kapolei Pkwy
- Need a good bikeway connection between UH West and Kapolei
- Need an alternative connection to Honokai Hale

Other Important Bikeway Items:

- Farrington Hwy bike lanes connecting all the way to Waipahu
- Coastal bike path connecting Oneula Beach to White Plains
- Roosevelt Ave bike lanes
- Coral Sea Rd bike lane important to recognize White Plains as a major destination
- Fort Barrette Rd needs bike lanes from Makakilo to Kalaeloa
- Kualakai Pkwy complete the bike path and formalize the wide shoulders as bike lanes
- Keahumoa Pkwy needs bike lanes the completed sections of the street don't have bike lanes nor a wide sidewalk/bike path
- The Kualakai Pkwy bike path should be extended to follow the rail through Hoopili and to Farrington Hwy

Other Important Items:

- Need better wayfinding
- Bikeway treatment at the intersection is critical
