The small group had a lot of ideas on how to make Manoa more bicycle friendly.

- Punahou Rd connecting all the way into Manoa should have a bike lane, priority on the climbing lane but ideal in both. This is important to provide a more direct route between Manoa and Downtown/Kakaako and areas further west
- University Avenue – bike lanes should extend continuously mauka to Maile Way, ideal if they're protected
- Need better wayfinding to Oahu Avenue
- Oahu Avenue climbing bike lane or traffic calming
- Manoa Road traffic climbing to improve biking environment
- Oahu Ave/University Ave/Alaula Way intersection needs a crossing treatment to facilitate making the left off of Oahu Ave
- Manoa Stream bike path would be great and should extend from Woodlawn Dr makai
- Need Biki at UHM campus and surrounding area
- Manoa Marketplace needs sufficient, quality bike parking
