The small group had a lot of ideas on making Waipahu, Waipio, and Waikele more bicycle friendly. These are shown below in a list.

- The Pearl Harbor Bike Path was seen as the most important biking facility and a top priority for improvement through lighting, pavement maintenance, security along the path, and better linking to it
- Dedicated bikeways linking mauka/makai, particularly on Kamehameha Hwy/Waipahu St and Paiwa St
- Path connecting Central Oahu Regional Park and Waikele (existing bike path on Paiwa St)
- While quite a ways from Waipahu, making a bike path connection at the eastern terminus of the Pearl Bike Path (by the Admiral's Boathouse) was a big priority
- Leeward Bikeway
- Waipio Point Access Road bike path from Farrington Hwy to Pearl Harbor Historic Trail
- Continuous bike lanes on Lumiana St between Managers Dr and Kamehameha Hwy
- Farrington Hwy bike lanes continuous through Waipahu
- A dedicated bikeway connection to the Pearlridge HART station
