Mission: Enable more people to ride bicycles for health, recreation, & transportation through advocacy, education, & events.



We lead the charge for safe streets to make Hawai'i a more bicycle & pedestrian friendly community working with government officials and mobilizing the community to propel forward impactful changes:

- 19.5 new miles of bikeways on O'ahu in 2017 & 2018
- 2018 Passage of Safe Passing 3 Feet the law
- 2019 Passage of Vision Zero law making safe streets for all with zero traffic deaths a state priority
- 2020 big projects moving forward Leeward Bikeway, and Pensacola St, Ward Ave, Bishop St protected bikeways



We educate drivers on safely sharing roads and bicyclists from keiki to kupuna to feel confident cycling, directly reaching over 10,000 in the last year:

- 8,000 4th Graders graduated from BikeEd with skills & knowledge to become the next generation of safe cyclists
- 750+ adults educated in our hands-on workshops empowering them to make cycling apart of their lives
- 1750+ motorists educated on safely sharing our roads with bicyclists and pedestrians



We put on large and small events that got nearly 5,000 bicyclists of all levels out cycling. Highlights:

- Riders in the Honolulu Century Ride (Hawai'i's largest cycling event) and Haleiwa Metric Century rode collectively 185,000 miles
- Zachary Manago's Ride in Paradise propelled forward the Zachary Manago Memorial Bikeway
- Our Annual Dinner & Fundraiser was the bike party of year celebrating the great momentum



We bring together the community around bicycling and spreading the joy of pedaling. Community summary:

- Our 2,100 members are at the core HBL giving us strength and propelling forward our work
- Our 24,000 email network & strong social media presence (4,000+ likes on Facebook) spreads our message and impact in growing bicycling & building safe streets for all
